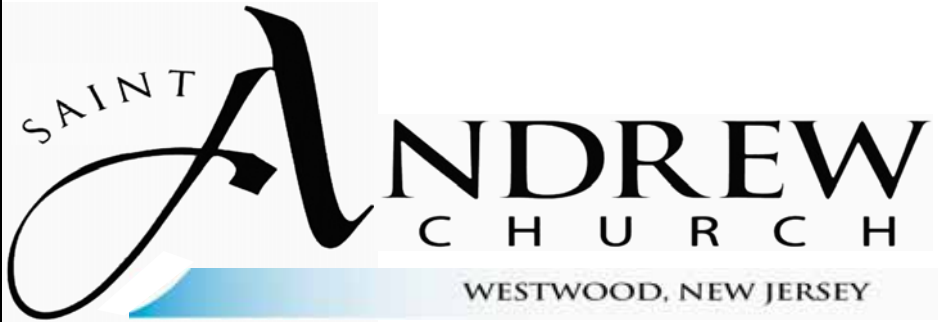

Pastor's Letter
