


Our parish is still seeking a part-time Music Director/Keyboardist. If you know someone who would be interested in this position, please contact me or the Parish Center.

To open the door, you must simply believe Jesus is the Son of God, and surrender your life to Him. When you do this, Christ will come into your life, forgive your sins, and become your Savior and intimate friend. Everything you've been looking for is wrapped up in Jesus. Open the door and enter into a loving relationship with Him.
