### Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

Happy Labor Day! Many people mark Labor Day as the end of summer season - their last chance for trips before the days of summer wind down. For our students, it is the end of care free summer days and a time to prepare themselves to go back to school. Many of us enjoy a day of rest, a day to gather with neighbors for barbecues, parties or sporting events since football season is just beginning. For our parish, we resume numerous activities and programs.

Let me share with you some of my thoughts as we begin the fall. Next week, I will begin training Adult Altar Servers. The adult servers usually serve for funerals. If you are able to find some time to serve at funeral masses, please call the office and let me know so we can include you in the training.

I also want to reinstate the Bereavement Ministry which is a very important ministry. Its purpose is to serve families who have lost a loved one, to give comfort and support to grieving families by giving them our time, hearing their thoughts and sharing their tears. If anyone would like to be a part of this ministry, please let me know.

I am also planning to create a Pre-Cana team. Under the auspices of the Archdiocese, the Pre-Cana seminar is given to engaged couples as part of their preparation for marriage. Those who serve on the Pre-Cana team are couples who find joy in sharing their knowledge and experiences to engaged couples preparing for marriage. It is my hope that through this, we can create a ministry that is geared to serving couples and families in our parish. Couples who would like to be part of this Pre-Cana team, please let me know.

I have always been an advocate of Faith Formation. How can we encourage Catholics to openly talk about their faith? Many Catholics, young and old, face opportunities every day to share their faith with others but lack the basic knowledge and confidence to do so. To address this issue, the Renew program was established and promoted some years ago. I would like to revive the Renew program for our parish. Some of our parishioners are very interested in this. If you or someone would like to be a part of this program, please let me know as well.

Our Parish Handbook is done. We are now preparing it for printing. Thanks to Fran Borg, our Parish Business Manager, who took the time to review and update it. All our current parish ministries are listed there. My hope is that, everyone will have a chance to see the many parish ministries we have and get involved. This is called Stewardship.

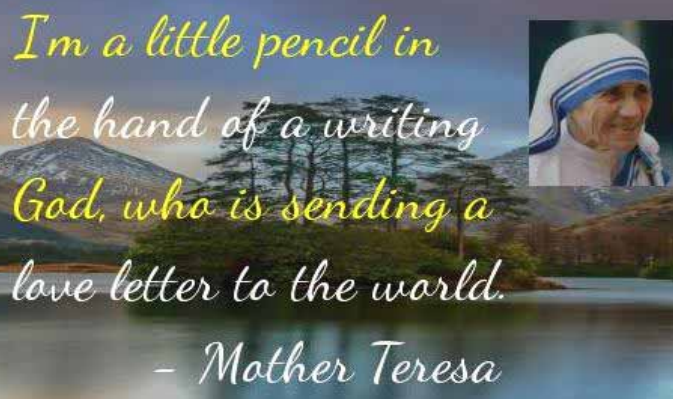
