Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

With the passing of the Labor Day holiday, we are resuming our busy parish schedule. I am pleased to tell you we are creating new ministries and reviving some important programs. With this, I would encourage all our parishioners to donate some time to participate and be actively involved in these new programs and activities.

This Sunday, the Church celebrates "Catechetical Sunday." Since 1935, the Church has formally acknowledged the importance of the Church's teaching ministry and to honor those who serve the community as catechists. I would like to thank and honor our parish catechists who serve our children in the Religious Education program. Thanks to Maura Roem, our Pastoral Associate for Child Catechesis, and Lori Zucaro, Secretary for Religious Education, and all the parish catechists, who devote so much of their time and effort serving our children. Thank you for your stewardship and service.

There are two major projects that we are currently undertaking. First, work has begun on the repair of the Church roof. Based on the recommendation of the Archdiocese, Arco Construction Inc. of West Caldwell will remove all existing roofing at the uppermost elevation of the Church building down to the original deck. They will also install new fluid-applied roofing, insulation with a twenty-year warranty, and all new drains.

The second project is the installation of a new sound system in the Church. Monte Bros. Sound System Inc. will undertake the project. I am hoping that this time, after so many experiments, we will finally solve the problem. As both projects require financial resources, I thank those who have been generously supporting these projects.

May God continue to bless us in all our programs and endeavors.

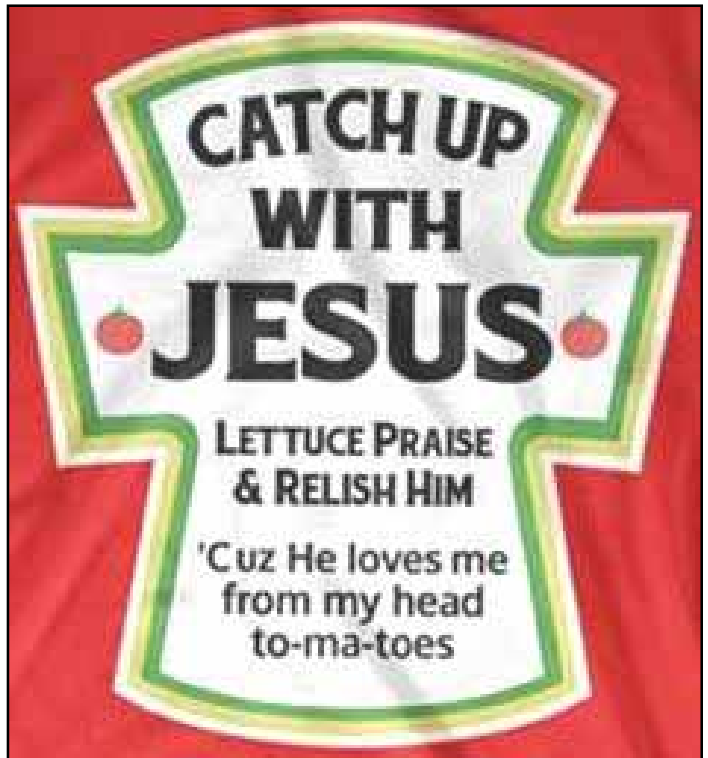


ST. ANTHONY'S TRICKY TRAY FUNDRAISER

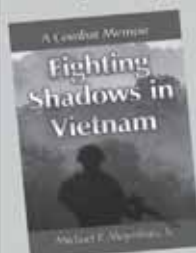
