Pastoral Reflection

Pope Francis Proposes Six New Beatitudes for the Modern Era

Pope Francis went to Sweden last week for the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. There were meetings with Lutheran Church leaders seeking an ecumenical dialogue on two main tracks: the narrow "street" of theological and institutional dialogue, and a much broader "avenue" in which Christians work together to bring God's mercy to a hurting world. Christ's followers are being called to "the ecumenism of mercy." "Ecumenism of mercy" is not putting aside the call to unity, but a way of responding to it, one that puts Christ at the center because of the more "pressing" needs such as the rise in migration, people-trafficking, and other symptoms of what the Pope calls the "throwaway culture."

Just look at the Gospel, Pope Francis says. "Samaritans and Jews had vast theological differences between their religious world views and institutions, yet whenever Jesus gave an example of how to help the poor, he gave Samaritans as an example. They could not meet on theological grounds, but they could meet in the poor." If the Churches lose their love of Christ in the flesh, in the poor, all the fine theological documents are emptied of meaning.

During his homily, the Pope proposed a series of six new blessings to add to the eight, known as the beatitudes, that Jesus said would come upon those who, among other things, were poor in spirit or acted as peacemakers.

Pope Francis said, "We are called to be blessed, to be followers of Jesus, to confront the troubles and anxieties of our age with the spirit and love of Jesus." He continued, "Thus we ought to be able to recognize and respond to new situations with fresh spiritual energy."

Francis then proposed six new beatitudes for the modern era:

- ◆ Blessed are those who remain faithful while enduring evils inflicted on them by others, and forgive them from their heart.
- ◆ Blessed are those who look into the eyes of the abandoned and marginalized, and show them their closeness.
- ◆ Blessed are those who see God in every person, and strive to make others also discover Him.
- ◆ Blessed are those who protect and care for our common home.
- ◆ Blessed are those who renounce their own comfort in order to help others.
- ◆ Blessed are those who pray and work for full communion between Christians.

All those who embrace these blessings, said the pontiff, "are messengers of God's mercy and tenderness, and surely they will receive from Him their merited reward."

The Beatitudes, given by Jesus during his Sermon on the Mount as recounted in Matthew's Gospel, are among the most recognizable of Jesus' teachings, as He names eight groups of people traditionally thought to be unfortunate but that He pronounces blessed—the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure of heart, the peacemakers, and the persecuted.

During this week, discuss these suggestions by Pope Francis with your friends and family.
