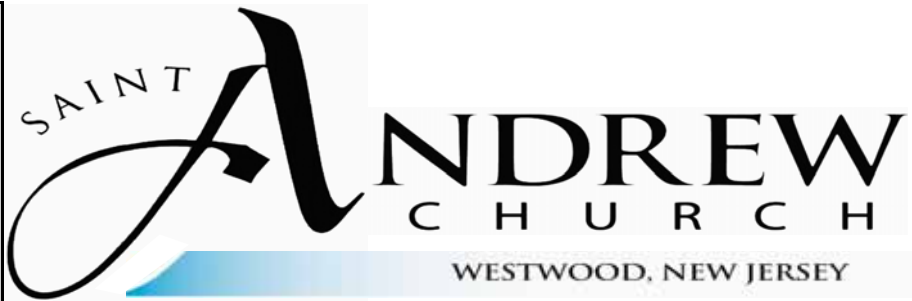

## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

### Pastoral Reflection

#### Praying the Mass

For the next Pastoral Reflections, we will be focusing on the Mass. If Christ had not risen from the dead, there would be no Eucharist as we know it. But the Eucharist is not a reenactment. It is real. It is "live." It is the Risen Lord Himself who leads every celebration of the Eucharist. It isn't something we do on our own. The Church teaches that the Mass is "the action of Christ and the People of God."

It is the Risen Lord, in His glorified body, who calls us together, who hosts the celebration, and invites us to join Him as He continues to give himself—and us—to the God He calls Abba. Christ did rise from the dead. That is why we get together every Sunday to celebrate the Eucharist and why every Sunday is "Little Easter."

We begin with **the Introductory Rites** which is the entrance procession to the Gathering Prayer. The biggest change in the Mass as a result of Vatican II is the change in *attitude* about the Mass and our role in it. No longer does the priest "say" the Mass while we "attend". Now the entire congregation joins itself to Christ in acknowledging the great things God has done and in offering the sacrifice.

Imagine a building with separate music rooms. Each person goes to one to individually practice their special instrument and play away without affecting each other. Compare that to an orchestra whose members bring their instruments and play the same song together. That is the difference. The Introductory Rites of the Mass helps us become an "orchestra." The purpose of these rites is so that the faithful coming together take on the form of a community. How do we pray this part of the Mass?

We pray it by remembering that we are *in this together*. The next time you are at Mass, focus for a few minutes on the people who are gathered there. Here we are, the Lord's own disciples in the year 2017, as diverse as Peter, Thomas, Mary Magdalene, and as imperfect as they were, yet called by name, sharing "one Lord, one Faith, one Baptism." It can be an eye-opening experience to be consciously aware of this diversity, yet our unity in faith.
