PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

Pastoral Reflection

REFLECTIONS ON THE MASS, PART 3

The Eucharistic Prayer, from beginning to end, is addressed to God the Father on behalf of the whole congregation. During the Eucharistic Prayer, the barriers of time are washed away. The action of Christ on the Cross as He gives himself entirely to the Father is made present to us so that we can join with Him in this same action.

If I asked the question, "At the Mass, who offers what?" some might respond that the priest offers Christ. Actually, the more correct response is: The whole Christ (all of us joined in Christ) offers the whole Christ (all of us joined to Christ). The Church's intention is that the faithful not only offers this victim but also learn to offer themselves.

That is what we do at every Mass. We make an act of faith that God is life, and the surest thing we can ever do is join with Jesus on the Cross and together, with Him, place ourselves in God's hands. Spend some quiet time entrusting yourself into God's hands.

The Communion Rite is when I come to receive Communion. The minister of the Eucharist says to me, "the Body of Christ" and "the Blood of Christ," and I say "Amen" to each. Those are the biggest "Amens" I will ever say. I am not simply saying "Amen" to the real presence. I am saying "Amen" to receiving the Lord *into my life*—not someday when I have got everything worked out, but here and now. In effect, I say, "Lord, I'm not perfect, and I don't have all the answers. But I do believe in you, and I accept you into my life here and now."

The cup has particular meaning. In Gethsemane, Jesus prayed, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me." The cup of suffering wasn't taken away but by accepting it, Jesus found the path to life. When I stand up before the cup and say "Amen", I am saying, "Lord, I accept, as you did, whatever sufferings cannot be taken away. I trust, as you trusted, that God will somehow make this something good. And I trust that if you are with me, I can do it." Think about those two Amens. Spend some time on each and the next time you receive Communion, say them with conviction that comes from way down deep inside.

When a movie ends, people simply get up and walk out of the theater. But the Mass is a communal ritual and needs a ritual ending. So, in the **Concluding Rite**, we are ritually blessed and then sent: "Go in peace."

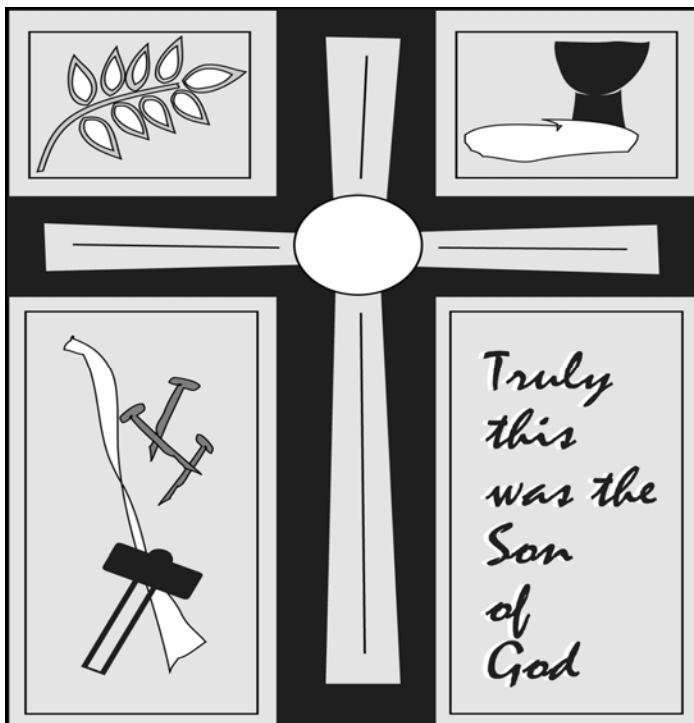
When the Liturgy was celebrated in Latin, the priest said, "Ite missa est." The Latin word "missa" means being "missioned," "sent." Since the 4th century, the whole celebration became known by that word: The Mass.
