

Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Trinity which is the most important tenet of our faith as Catholics. But, do we know anything about it? Does it have any significance in our lives? Or, is it merely a theological concept that we have to accept and believe without question. The truth is, one of the first prayers we Catholics learn is the simple and beautiful sign of the cross. Many of us, consciously or otherwise, invoke the Holy Trinity every time we enter a Church, when we traditionally dip our fingers in the holy water font and bless ourselves. Every time we begin the Holy Mass, we bless ourselves with the invocation of the Holy Trinity. When we recite the profession of faith at Mass, we invoke our belief in the Holy Trinity - the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It is the same Trinitarian formula in which we are baptized into our Catholic faith.


What is the Holy Trinity? And why do we believe God as Trinity? The doctrine of the Holy Trinity is one of the most difficult tenets of our faith to understand and explain, simply because it defies human logic and our words are inadequate to explain it. That is precisely why it is called a "mystery." Nonetheless, it is true because Jesus Himself revealed it to us. Therefore, we believe it and accept it. During Christ's final mandate, he mentioned about the Trinity when he said: "Go, therefore, into the whole world, teach all nations; baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit". This is the Triune God in a capsule. How do we experience Him as a Triune God affecting our lives? We may know God as a dogma or doctrine, but how do we see, touch, smell and hear this mystery and invisible God? Helen Keller, an American author, once remarked: "We experience God through each other." When we forget ourselves and reach out to people, especially those in need, we do not only experience happiness but also experience the unselfish Triune God.

Today, we hear one of the most beautiful passages in the New Testament: "God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." What do we have to do in order to receive this immense gift of eternal life? Believe in the Son. Is that really all we have to do? Mere knowledge of this truth in and of itself is not enough if it is not backed up by faith and good deeds. What is needed is to obey God's voice and do His will. In the book of James, it says: "For just as a body without a spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead." Jesus also says, "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples if you have love for one another." Love is the distinguishing mark by which you can tell the true Christian from the false.


