Pastoral Reflection

THE POWER OF CHILDREN

"Never underestimate what children can do. Little steps, taken over the years, on a daily basis, show the power of children."

—Theresa Kielberger (Craig's mother)

In 1995, a headline in the *Toronto Star* caught the attention of 12 year old Craig Kielberger. The story told about another 12 year old boy who lived in Pakistan and who had been sold into child labor at age four. The boy had been murdered in Pakistan after publically speaking out about child labor. Craig didn't know what "child labor" meant. He wasn't even sure where Pakistan was. But, he knew about being 12 years old and he could not imagine living a life of forced labor and danger.

And, he wanted to help. Craig might not have money but he did have family and friends. He soon enlisted them to join his fight against child labor. Today, Kielbergers's international program, "Feed the Children", focuses on educational opportunities for children around the world. It has built more than 450 schools, delivered more than 202,500 school and health kits to children, and provided health care centers and community funding to help more than 505,000 people worldwide.

His work with "Feed the Children" has given Kielberger "a gift" he says. "When I was in Thailand, I saw a street girl with an orange. She automatically took it and split it with her friend—no question about the matter. What did that teach him? "God works through us."

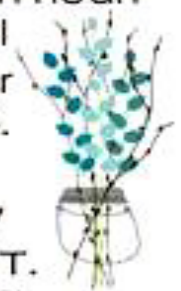

Nothing will be impossible for you." Without realizing it, we can be penned in like sheep with our schedules, activities our possessions.
