Pastoral Reflection

The Virtue of Hope

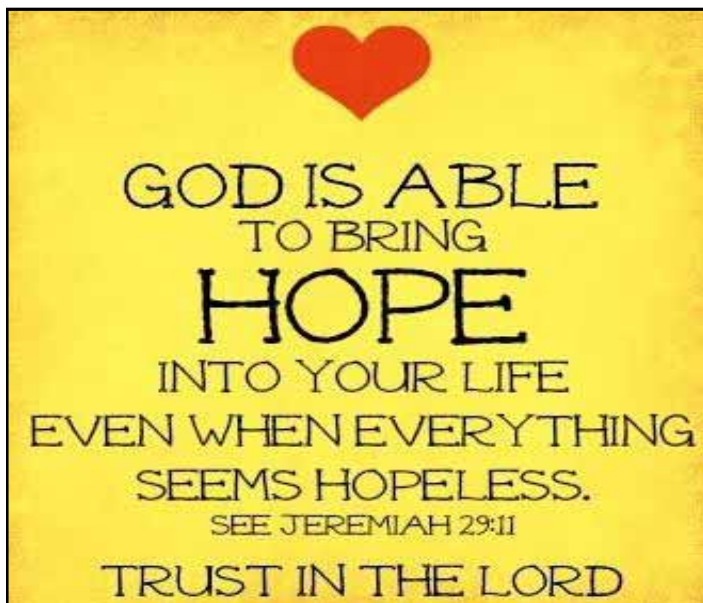
Our celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus during the Easter season brings us back to the topic of hope again and again. The theological virtue of hope means three things:

- ◆ It comes straight from God: Hope is called an infused virtue or a direct gift from God, which is a pretty good source. It is not a feeling we conjure up within ourselves, simply a positive attitude. It comes from God.
◆ It goes straight to God: There are many lesser things we might wish for such as "I hope it rains tomorrow." But, the virtue of hope is outrageous in its expectations. God gives us the gift of expecting everything, and God tells us that we can have everything.
◆ It is grounded in God right now: Hope is not hanging somewhere out in the future. It is based on the living experience of God, NOW, because God exists NOW, and we can experience God NOW. Hope is the enjoyment of NOW, of what God HAS done and IS doing for us, and the anticipation already of what God WILL do for us.

Hope is something real, full, rich, rugged, strong, because hope comes from God and goes directly to God and God is real right now. We use analogies to talk about God. But these are only hints of what God is like. God is personal, like a parent, but God is beyond our understanding of person. God is living, but beyond our understanding of life...loving, but beyond our understanding of love...good, but beyond our understanding of goodness...powerful but beyond our understanding of power.

To think about God we have to expand our minds to its widest, and then stand at our mind's edge and realize that God is far, far beyond that. God is beyond words, beyond even our wildest imaginings. God has a greatness that we cannot fit into our minds. Hope is an extravagant EXPECTATION of everything because God exists and God loves me and God is everything.

Don't just put your hope IN God. Give thanks that your hope comes FROM God.
