## PENTECOST SUNDAY

### Pastoral Reflections

#### HOLY SPIRIT, COME WITH YOUR FIRE

The letters of St. Paul, written roughly between 50 and 60 AD, contain advice about prayer. A few examples:

"The Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself interceded." (Rom. 8:26)

"With all prayer and supplication, pray at every opportunity in the Spirit." (Eph. 6:18)

"Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks." (1 Thess. 5:17-18)

Paul emphasized that we not only want to pray but we also **need** to pray to the Spirit. When we pray, we never have to worry about what to say. The Spirit is within each of us and all each of us has to do is open ourselves to the guidance of the Spirit and see where the Spirit leads.

There is no simpler, more beautiful, more refreshing way of praying than simply to give thanks to God. Prayer does not flatter God because God does not need flattery. Giving thanks to God is like a small child who gives a bouquet of dandelions to his mother. It is a simple recognition of how much his mother loves him and how much he loves his mother.

We can give thanks to God for all sorts of things—sunshine, a cup of coffee, a home. When we thank God, we get in touch with the deepest, most beautiful truths of our faith. When we say thanks, we experience the goodness of God. It is truly right and good to give God thanks and praise.
