Pastoral Reflection

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." (Jn. 20:21-22)

Sometimes we think of religion as a system that's always telling us: You have to do this....you have to do that....don't forget to give your time...to give your money...

Sure, that's part of it but that's not the heart of our faith. The most exciting part of our faith is discovering how much the Lord loves each one of us and enjoying that discovery.

The Lord has given me the Spirit so that I may have life and be more fulfilled, more alive, knowing that I am loved, that I have a destiny, and that I am worth something. God has given me so much. Sure, I work hard to earn much of what I have. But who gave me the intellect? The energy? The opportunity? Who filled me with the Spirit?

The truth is God cannot be outdone in generosity. Jesus has plans for this world. He has become part of it, and He planted seeds in it—His teachings, His way of life, God's own goodness. These did not spring from the world. They came from God and He invites us to join with Him.

God has plans for creation—and the ultimate plan is the Kingdom of God. We are grateful. We are grateful that the world exists, that we have a free country, that we have a Church, that we have an extended family, that we as individuals exist, and we have Jesus as our brother.

But our thanksgiving is not meant to be a perfunctory "thank you." Think of all we can do with the gifts that God has given us...just like a new parent who is thankful for a new child and thinks of all they want for this child.

President John F. Kennedy said, "The country cannot afford to be materially rich and spiritually poor." Food for thought.

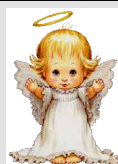
