THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Pastoral Reflection

CONFRONTATION, CONVERSION, CONSOLATION

During Advent, Christians should examine their lives on a more adult level than just focusing on the birth of Jesus. The second and third Sunday Gospel readings about John the Baptist first CONFRONT us with the bigger picture of "God's Kingdom" and the need for conversion with the water of Baptism that will bring "Spirit and Fire."

Jesus describes John as the "greatest" and then the "least" in His new Kingdom. In his story, John lets his ego decrease so that Jesus can increase. The ego, a person's sense of self-esteem or self-importance, can also be defined as "Edging God Out." Confronting our own ego and our real relationship with God is important to our growth in faith.

The power of CONVERSION to the different world view of God's Kingdom requires focus on what is grace-filled, good, true and beautiful to replace shame, guilt or fear. It is not the Word of God threatening us with fire and brimstone. It is goodness being its own reward and evil its own punishment. We are punished not FOR our sins but BY our sins.

CONSOLATION brings deep healing and reconstructs in us with a new mind and a new heart. We are always the "stable" into which Christ is born anew. All we can do is keep our stable honest and humble, decreasing our egos, and Christ will surely be born in us.

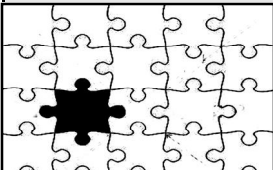
Through the Incarnation, God in Jesus became flesh; God visibly moved in with the material world to help us overcome the idea that God is elsewhere" (John 1:14). God as Holy Spirit is precisely known as an indwelling and vitalizing presence. The Incarnation and Indwelling Spirit are known only through participation and practice, when you actively draw upon such Infinite Sources. "Use it or lose it!"

May this Advent bring all of us to a more profound recognition of the meaning of Christmas.

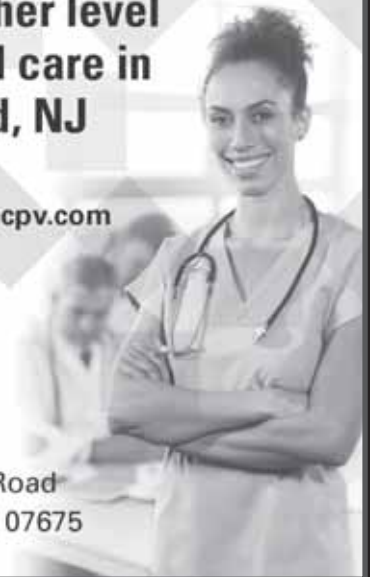
