Dear Father Weiner:

Clergy members of my staff have apprised me of the current situation with regard to your parochial vicar, Reverend Rafael I. Galvez-Pineda. They have taken great care to hear his concerns while also being attentive to your needs and concerns, as well as those of all the parishioners of Saint Andrew. I know they have conveyed my pastoral concern for you, Father Galvez-Pineda and the parish and the need to determine necessary further action.

I am granting Father Galvez-Pineda a limited six-week period of discernment effective Monday, April 2, 2018. When he returns by May 14, 2018, I will assess his personal status as well as his future ministry. However, I have already determined that he will not return to Saint Andrew's Parish given his twelve years there. Please know that I am working with my staff, and I know my staff is working directly with you, to resolve the needs his vacancy and all the current challenges present for Saint Andrew and for you personally as a new Pastor of this important parish of the Archdiocese.




